

**2 He also brought me up out of a horrible pit,** Psalm 16:7-11 being quoted and attributed to Jesus by Peter in Acts 2 gives us the authority for seeing this as a prayer of Jesus’.

**Out of the miry clay,  
And set my feet upon a rock,  
And established my steps.**

**4 Blessed is that man who makes the LORD his trust,** The “man Christ Jesus” (1 Timothy 2:5-6) trusted the LORD!

**And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.**

**5 Many, O LORD my God, are Your wonderful works** My commentary on Mark 6:48 deals somewhat with Job 9:10 and its marvel.

**Which You have done;  
And Your thoughts toward us  
Cannot be recounted to You in order;  
If I would declare and speak of them,  
They are more than can be numbered.**

#### **40:6**

**Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened.** Exodus 22:1 speaks of a man having his “ear opened”. There it says “bored with an awl.” Jesus gave Himself as a timeless servant to His Father. Hebrews 10:5 sees this in the act of the incarnation. Jesus took upon Himself the form of a slave (Philippians 2:5-8) and is still in that form today (mankind, 1 Timothy 2:5-6).

1. This was a body prepared by God (Hebrews 10:5).
2. It is a body prophesied by David (Psalm 40:6).
3. It is a body pleasing for sacrifice (**Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require** and Hebrews 10:4).
4. It’s a body profoundly submitted (Hebrews 10:9).
5. It’s a body perfect for sanctification (Hebrews 10:12-14).
6. It’s a body that presides over His enemies (Hebrews 10:13).
7. It’s a body that purges the memory of God (Hebrews 10:16-18).
8. It’s a body that provision for access to God (Hebrews 10:19).
9. It’s a body that makes possible the profession of the believer (Hebrews 10:22).
10. It is a body persevering in its duty (Hebrews 10:23).
11. It is a body prized the by the receiver (Hebrews 10:29).

**7 Then I said, “Behold, I come;  
In the scroll of the book it is written of me.**

**8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart.”** So Jesus has a body (verse 6) and a **heart**. Psalm 16:7-11 (mentioned in verse 2) speaks of Jesus having a soul.
