 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.

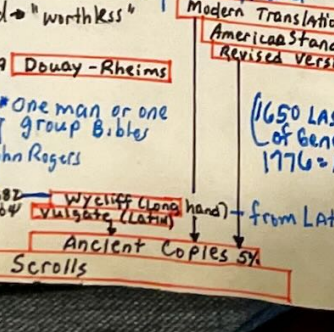
HOW long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?
 2 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?
 3 Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death;
 4 Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved. Don't quit/Give up
 5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation. - Physical perseverance

THE fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. - Rom 3:10-12
 2 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.
 3 They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one. - Natural man's relationship to God (reject in heart) (His inclination)

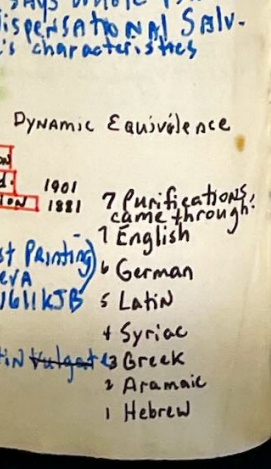
