

**Qualifications for Leadership:
Not Greedy (Sordid) for Gain (Titus 1:7)**

1. Greedy for Gain (Philippians 4:8)

Sordid: sleazy, shoddy (poorly made or done), vile and tawdry (flashy but cheap).

The disposition of your heart and motives for gain is more important to God than the gain acquired as a result of that pursuit.
