- 3. Read **Colossians 4:3-6** and **2 Timothy 2:24-26**. How might a Christian be prepared for rejection without becoming cynical and pessimistic regarding the non-Christians he encounters from day to day?
- 4. Read **Romans 12:17-21**. What are some of the subtle (and not so subtle) ways you have "taken your own revenge" against those who have maligned you or rejected you because of your relationship with Christ?
- 5. Read **Matthew 10:23** and **Acts 13:46-47**. What are some of the negative ramifications associated with stubbornly continuing to invest all of your time and effort in winning back those who reject you because of your Christianity?
