- A. God required His people in the OT to bring sacrifices regularly and often.
- B. Remember the main lesson which each sacrifice teaches us about our worship of Jehovah:

Old Testament Sacrifices (5) The Trespass Offering

- I. In Israel.
 - A. God prescribed at least five circumstances in which the Israelite was to bring a T.O.
 - B. God prescribed the way in which a man was to bring his T.O.
 - C. God promised that in the way of bringing the T.O. the believer would enjoy forgiveness.
- II. In Christ.
 - A. Jesus Christ was the fulfillment of every OT sacrifice; in every respect, then, He was the fulfillment of the T.O.
 - B. Isaiah 53:10 underscores that His death was a trespass offering.
- III. For Us.
 - A. The T.O. teaches us the need to guard against ignorance and forgetfulness with regard to the duties we owe God and our neighbor.
 - B. The T.O. teaches us that we must do all in our power to remove the effects our sins have on others.
 - C. The T.O reminds us of the need to have and show true love to God and our neighbor.
