"Esther Becomes Queen" Esther 2:12-20

- I. FORCE: "go in to King Ahasuerus" (vv.12-14)
 - **A. Conclusion:** "the turn of each young lady" (v.12)
 - **B. Conscription:** "would go in...in this way" (vv.13-14)
 - 1. Aids: "take...anything that she desired" (v.13)
 - 2. Approval: "In the evening/go in...in the morning/return" (v.14)
 - a. Process: "evening...morning...second harem" (v.14a)
 - b. Permission: "not again go in...unless...delighted/summoned" (v.14b)
 - (1) Captivated: "unless the king delighted in her"
 - (2) Called: "unless...she was summoned by name"
- II. FAVOR: "the king loved Esther" (vv.15-17)
 - **A. Compliance:** "advised...Esther found favor" (v.15)
 - **B. Confrontation:** "Esther taken to King Ahasuerus" (v.16)
 - **C. Coronation:** "royal crown...made her queen" (v.17)
 - 1. Preference: "found favor and kindness...more than all" (v.17a)
 - 2. Position: "set the royal crown and made queen" (v.17b)
- III. <u>FEAST</u>: "the king gave a great banquet" (vv.18-20)
 - A. Celebrated: "Esther's banquet...holiday...gifts" (v.18)
 - 1. Party: "gave a great banquet for all his princes/servants" (v.18a)
 - 2. Pause: "made a holiday for the provinces" (v.18b)
 - 3. Presents: "gave gifts according to the king's bounty" (v.18c)
 - **B. Concerned:** "Mordecai...at the king's gate" (v.19)
 - C. Concealed: "not yet made known her people" (v.20)
