

## The Glory of the Christ: His Impeccable Nature

- 1. A Historical Observation: Jesus was able not to sin.
  - Jesus was perfectly holy. (Luke 1:35)
  - Jesus resisted all temptation. (Matthew 4:1-11 // Mark 1:12-13 // Luke 4:1-13)
- 2. A Theological Deduction: Jesus was not able to sin.
  - Jesus is fully human. (John 1:14)
  - Jesus is fully divine. (John 1:1; James 1:13)
  - Jesus' temptation was both legitimate and futile. (Hebrews 4:15)
- 3. A Practical Consideration: Jesus was able to pay for sin.
  - Jesus' died a sacrificial death as our substitute. (Romans 5:8; 1 Peter 2:24)
  - Jesus' intercedes for us as our great High Priest. (Hebrews 7:23-25)
