## Putting On The “Garments Of Salvation”

Isaiah 61:1-4, 10-11 (620)

“Evangel Preaching” 3 of 5

*The Robe* was one of the best-selling Biblical novels of the 1940s. The book (later a motion picture) presented a speculative tale about the soldier who won Jesus’ robe through a dice game. Today Isaiah presents to us another kind of tale and another kind of clothing – referred to here as “the robe of righteousness” (v 10c). Consider the present condition of your own “spiritual clothing” and quickly put on the wondrous “garments of salvation” (v 10b). You and all people *need to be covered* with this rich and luxuriant clothing!
