- I. Sound Discipline (6-9)
 - A. Make sure you preaching is in keeping with the pursuit of godliness
 - B. You are nourished by the word and sound doctrine
 - C. Avoid fables, pursue righteousness of spiritual life
 - 1. Promises now
 - 2. Promises later
- II. Sound Confession (10-11)
 - A. Why should we strive for this? Because of the work of God
 - B. We fix our hope on the **living** God
 - 1. Savior of all men
 - 2. Especially (particularly) those who believe
 - C. Prescribe to and teach these things! A simple, yet profound message
- III. Sound Public Practice (12-16)
 - A. Let the gospel create maturity in you
 - 1. Demonstrate that maturity in all areas of your life
 - 2. Speech, conduct, love, faith, purity
 - B. Give public attention to:
 - 1. The reading of Scripture
 - 2. Exhortation
 - 3. Teaching
 - C. Give personal attention to:

- 1. The spiritual gift affirmed by the church and its leadership in your life
- 2. Pursue to cultivate it as a diligent work
 - a. Pay close attention to it Why?
 - b. Your salvation and the salvation of those who hear you
