ALTHOUGH CHRIST, BY HIS OBEDIENCE AND DEATH, DID MAKE A PROPER, REAL, AND FULL SATISFACTION TO GOD'S JUSTICE IN THE BEHALF OF THEM THAT ARE JUSTIFIED; A YET IN AS MUCH AS GOD ACCEPTETH THE SATISFACTION FROM A SURETY, WHICH HE MIGHT HAVE DEMANDED OF THEM, AND DID PROVIDE THIS SURETY, HIS OWN ONLY SON, B IMPUTING HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS TO THEM, AND REQUIRING NOTHING OF THEM FOR THEIR JUSTIFICATION BUT FAITH, WHICH ALSO IS HIS GIFT, THEIR JUSTIFICATION IS TO THEM OF FREE GRACE.
