"The King's Messengers" You Go Where Jesus Himself Will Go: In Salvation Or Judgment!

Luke 10:1-16

There is an interesting textual variant in our passage today. Did Jesus send out *seventy-two* "others" or *seventy*? There seems to be an important OT connection here, although scholars debate exactly what linkage is intended. However Jesus labors to mobilize and energize his followers "to go where he himself was about to go" (v1). He commissioned them – and us -- to evangelize with the message that "the kingdom of God has come near" (v 9, 11, 16). Let us hear and receive this "Great Commission" of Luke's Gospel!
