


- A. Works by covenanted people are examined and rewarded by the LORD Matt 25:14-30

 5. Work done: faithful in what one is given; reward given: faithful in little, ruler in much

- B. Foolish stewardship or wicked stewardship was proof of no continuing faith in the Master or actual distrust of the LORD, no motivation to work therefore a false servant and not a part of the Master's eternal household


1. Mere identity through birth or position is NOT justification with God
2. Only continuing, justifying faith in what God has revealed puts one in a position to be rewarded for his work
3. Only personal confidence in the character of God and corresponding love for Him will put one in a place to be diligent in his stewardship



4. *Judgment is reward for works done out of a personal relationship with God; works do not put one in a relationship with God but is the evidence of one*
 5. *Where there is no confidence in God's character no work will be done and therefore no reward given; instead one experiences eternal loss!*
 6. *In those cases, God gives no reward, for one already has it! He opted to have his reward only here and not for eternity!*
 7. *We turn every thing we do to eternal value when we change the object for whom it is done Eph 6:5-9; Col 3:17, 22-25; 1 Cor 6:20*
- C. *All those NOT in the household perish eternally*

 2. *As with all people, God gave them ample opportunity to see the reality of God and turn to Him; they rejected it*
 3. *They are judged at the Great White Throne judgment after the Millennium*
