

***The Blessing of Jacob***  
**Genesis 26:34-27:29**

Main Point:

God's purposes can never be thwarted; therefore, when it seems as if they're not coming to pass as they should, wait patiently upon the Lord in active faith.

1. Sometimes it will seem as if God's purposes are not coming to pass as they should.

2. When this happens, you may think you need to help God.

3. You shouldn't try to help God because it usually requires sin on your part.

4. You also shouldn't try to help God because He doesn't need it.

5. Instead, you should wait patiently upon Him in active faith.
