## Fooling Ourselves

Luke 12:13-21 Pastor Phil Winfield January 17, 2010

And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."

Luke 12:15

- We are fooling ourselves when we equate wealth with worth verse 15
- We are fooling ourselves when we take <u>credit</u> for God's work verse 16
  - Deuteronomy 8:17-18 then you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.' <sup>18</sup> "And you shall remember the LORD your God, for *it is* He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it is* this day.
- We are fooling ourselves when we fail to seek God's counsel 17-19 "I will"
  - James 4:13-16 Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit"; <sup>14</sup> whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away. <sup>15</sup> Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that."
- We are fooling ourselves when we fail to see <u>man's need</u> verse 17-19 "<u>My crops, my</u> <u>barns, my goods my soul"</u>
- We are fooling ourselves when we mistake the body for the soul verse 19
  - Matthew 16:26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?
- We are fooling ourselves when we mistake time for eternity verse 19
  - Luke 12:4-5 "And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. <sup>5</sup> But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear Him who, after He has killed, has power to cast into hell; yes, I say to you, fear Him!
- We are fooling ourselves when we think of enjoying life while facing death. Verse 20
  - Wealth can not <u>keep you alive</u>
  - Wealth can not <u>buy back opportunities</u>
  - Wealth can not pay for your future
- We are fooling ourselves when we equate stewardship with ownership . Verse 21
  - Deuteronomy 10:14 Indeed heaven and the highest heavens belong to the LORD your God, also the earth with all that is in it.
  - Ps 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, The world and those who
    dwell therein.
  - Haggai 2:8 'The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says the LORD of hosts.
