## Teachable truth for troubling times:

- Verses 1-7: God may make us experience some <u>hardship</u> so that he might teach us dependency.
- Verses 8-16: God may ask us to recognize his <u>lordship</u> so that he might show us his <u>sufficiency</u>.
- Verses 17-24: God may ask us to endure the <u>unthinkable</u> so that we might receive the <u>impossible!</u>

What to do when things go wrong when you are doing right.

- **<u>Delight</u>** in what God has provided (verses 4-6)
- <u>Depend</u> upon God not the provision (verse 7)
- Obey God's word: that is how we pass God's test (verse 15)
- Obey God's word: that is how we tap <u>God's supply</u> (verse 16)
- Don't fret: Heartaches received from God clarify our priorities (verses 17-18)
- Don't faint: Heartaches given back to God <u>magnifies his Sovereignty</u> (verses 19-24)
