An Affluent Beginning

- Sons of a prominent and prosperous fisherman – Mk 1:20
 - Sons of Zebedee cited six times
 - Mt 20:20; 26:37; 27:56; Mk 10:35; Lk 5:10; Jn 21:2
- Partners with Simon (Peter) Lk 5:10
- Family known to the High Priest Jn 18:15f.
- John, younger brother
- Jesus' cousin(?) cf. Mt 27:55f; Mk 15:40; Jn 19:25

John's Background, 1

- Disciple of John the Baptist, then Jesus Jn 1:35, 36-40
 - Apparently only part-time at first Mt 4:21
 - Chosen by Jesus to be one of his Disciples Lk 5:10f.
- Boavhpyés, from Aramaic, ben regesh, Sons of Thunder
 - Passionate, zealous, fervent
 - Filled with Zeal for Jesus
 - Fire from heaven? Lk 9:54
 - Protection of the Chosen Ones? Lk 9:49

John's Background, 2

- More known of John than any other, except Peter
- Part of the Three (Peter, James and John)
 - Watched Jesus heal synagogue official's daughter –
 Mk 5:37
 - Witnessed the transfiguration of Jesus Mt 17:1
 - − With Jesus in Gethsemane Mt 26:36f.
- Wrangled and connived for a top spot in Jesus' government – Mt 20:20-23
- The disciple "Jesus loved"
 - Jn 13:23; 19:26; 20:2; 21:7, 20

To the Truth! It is Either Black or White

- Life v. Death Jn 5:24; 1 Jn 3:14
- Kingdom of God v. K. of Satan Jn 3:3ff.; 8:44
- Children of God v. Ch. of Satan 1 Jn 3:10
- Judgment of Righteous v. J. of wicked Jn 5:24;
 Rev 20:11-15
- Resurrection of Life v. R. of judgment Jn 5:29
- Receiving Christ v. Rejecting Christ Jn 1:10f.

To the Truth! It is Either Black or White

- Obedience v. Disobedience Jn 3:36
- We either walk in Light, or in Darkness Jn 12:35; 1 Jn 1:7
- We are either of God or of the World 1 Jn 2:15
- If Born of God, one cannot sin 1 Jn 3:9
- One who rejects Christ has not God Jn 5:23; 1 Jn 2:23
- Doer of Good is of God v. Doer of Evil Has Not Seen
 God 3 Jn 11
- John used the Greek word for "truth" ($a \lambda \eta \theta \in a$) 45 x
 - See 3 Jn4:2; 1 Jn 2:4; 1:6, 8

Watch Out for Anti-Christs

- They distort and deny the true Jesus
 - Came from within the Church 1 Jn 2:18
 - Their exit shows that they were not of us 2:19
- They deny that Jesus is the Christ 2:22
 - Denial of Jesus as the Son of God is denial of God, who testified of Jesus' identity – 5:9f.; Jn 5:32-38; 8:19
- They try to deceive the Faithful 1 Jn 2:26 (3:7); see also Ro 16:18 1 Ti 4:1; 2 Ti 3:13; Titus 1:10; 2 Jn 7
 - In like manner as their father, the Devil Jn 8:44; see also
 2 Co 11:3; Rev 12:9
- Many have already gone out-reject them 2 Jn 7-11
