AS WE COME TO A NEW YEAR... PHILIPPIANS 3:12-16

Introduction

As we view the writings and the life of the Apostle Paul, he admittedly had his share of both problems and imperfections! Yet, he was a man who, after his conversion, lived about as practical and as holy as any man ever could before the LORD!

How was he able to do that? I think we find the answer to that question in this passage of Scripture in Philippians 3, especially in verse 13.
