FACTSABOUTTHEBOOKOF

- 1. The New Testament quotes or alludes to Isaiah more than any other Old Testament book except for the Psalms.
- 2. Isaiah is placed first in the section of the prophetic books, not because of its sixty-six chapters, but because of its content and style. Jeremiah is 12% longer than Isaiah.
- 3. The New Testament quotes 148 times from chapters 1-39, and 261 times from chapters 40-66.



Isaiah and his wife, the prophetess, had two sons. The meaning of their names embodies the message of Isaiah.

Maher-shalal-bash-baz - "Swift the spoil, speedy the plunder" - relates to God's judgment on His people

Shear-Jashub - "a remnant will return" - relates to God's mercy towards His people


