## God's Word or My Opinion?

2 Timothy 2:15 and 3:16-17

## **PROBLEM (2 Timothy 2:15)**

"Be diligent ... as a workman ... accurately handling the word of truth."

## PROCESS

**Why Study** – 2 *Timothy 3:16 (NAS95) All Scripture is* <u>inspired</u> by God and <u>profitable</u> for <u>teaching</u>, for <u>reproof</u>, for <u>correction</u>, for training in <u>righteousness</u>;

- How to study 2 Timothy 2:15, (NAS95) <u>Be diligent</u> to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, <u>accurately handling the word of</u> <u>truth.</u> This is where you roll up your sleeves and do 3 things:
  - 1. **Observation** What does Scripture say? Ask who, what, where, when, why, and how. Look into the parts of speech and grammar.
  - 2. Interpretation What does Scripture mean? Look at the context, culture, history, grammar, and whether it's literal or figurative.
  - **3. Application** What does it mean to me? What do I learn about God? Is there a command that's relevant to here and now? Is there an example to follow or a principle to apply?

**Results of Study** – 2 *Timothy* 3:17 "...so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work."

## PROFIT (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

*"All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable..."* This is how we are useful to God – we get *"equipped for every good work."*
