Weekly Bible Verses

The Meaning Of “Repentance”

The Greek word for “repentance” is METANOIA. It means “a change of the mind.” Regarding salvation, I define the word as the need of every one in the world to change his or her mind regarding two things: (1) regarding sin, that is, to admit that they are sinners and condemned to Hell. (2) regarding the Saviour, that is, to realize that the Lord Jesus Christ is able to forgive their sins. After these two phases of “repentance” or a “change of mind,” the person must genuinely believe in and trust the Lord Jesus Christ as the One Who died for them and can give them everlasting life. Genuine faith in the Saviour and these two phases of “repentance” are combined to achieve the salvation of the person’s soul.
