Zephaniah God of both Judging and Rejoicing! Minor Prophets January 7 and 14, 2024

Main point: at the final judgment our God will be both judging and rejoicing!

Summary of the Book of Zephaniah:

Zephaniah, our ninth minor prophet presentation in our 'God-theater,' starts off with the prophet announcing God's severe judgment! As in all 12 minor prophets, 'judgment unto restoration' is found here. God's intention is not merely to destroy everyone, but rather to transform people from each nation into His worshippers. A subset of humanity will do what is prophesied in 3:12, when they "...shall seek refuge in the name of The LORD..." God is both powerful in judgment and powerful in redemption, so God rejoices over us with singing! (3:17)
