AN OLD TRUTH FOR THE NEW YEAR

1. The Lord doesn't want you to fear anything or anyone.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

2. You need not fear because the I AM is with you.

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. John 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.

Isaiah 9:6 ...And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Psalms 118:6 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me? Proverbs 29:25 The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Matthew 28:20 ...And, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen. Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

3. Don't let anything rob you of your confidence in God.

Isaiah 37:33-35

Hebrews 13:5-6 ...For he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. 6 So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

4. The Lord will give you the strength you need to accomplish His will.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. See Psam 27:1

Deut. 33:25 Thy shoes shall be iron and brass; and as thy days, so shall thy strength be.

5. The Lord will also help you.

1 Samuel 7:12 Then Samuel took a stone, and set it between Mizpeh and Shen, and called the name of it Ebenezer, saying, Hitherto hath the LORD helped us.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

6. The Lord will also hold you up.

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Psalms 37:23-24 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way. 24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.

Luke 12:4-5 I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. 5 But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.
