Entertainment: A Definition

Any action that is *calculated* to provide diversion, pleasure, interest, or amusement.

- Includes more common forms: TV, movies, gaming, internet, music
- Also includes broader categories: hobbies, leisure, recreation

What is Worldliness?

1 John 2:15-17

- The World is not to be loved.
- The World is directly opposed to God.
- The World is ultimately defined by selfish desires.
- The World will meet its ultimate end.
- Worldliness: a lifestyle of pursuing temporal desires without regard for God's eternal guidelines.

The Worldliness Issue

Timeless Principles:

- You have been bought by Christ's blood. (1 Cor. 6:19-20)
- You can only copy ("conform to") one set of ideals. (Rom. 12:2)
- The Word holds true believers to a high standard. (Deut. 7:26)
- Be defined by Christ, not society. (Eph. 5:7-12)
