Pastors' Children Must Behave

I told my four sons and my daughter when I was a pastor in Newton, Massachusetts that since I was a pastor and had to meet this qualification, if any of them got out of line I could not be a pastor anymore. I am not talking about pastors’ children who are not under his roof. A pastor has no control over his children who don’t live with him anymore. If a pastor’s children do not obey him, then, according to God’s Word he should resign from the ministry. Sometimes such a pastor resigns and the deacons talk him into staying. The pastor should obey the Lord and not listen in this matter to other people, including his deacons.
