- I. **The Author – The Apostle Paul**
- II. **Date and Background** – Paul wrote this letter in 57-58 A.D. when he was in the city of Corinth on his third missionary journey.
- III. **Theme** – The good news of the gospel (the saving righteousness of God) is available to all people through faith.
- IV. **Content**
