### I. The theme of the Psalm Vs 1

- A. The \_\_\_\_\_:
  - 1. Only fools say in their hearts, "There is no God."
  - 2. Cf. Rom 1:18-31-How far this mentality and belief system will lead a person
- B. The \_\_\_\_\_:
  - 1. They are corrupt, and their actions are evil
  - 2. Psalm 10:4 The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts.
- C. The \_\_\_\_\_: The fool does nothing good!

### II. The searching, \_\_\_\_\_ God Vs 2

- A. The LORD looks down from heaven on the entire human race;
- B. He looks to see if there is even one with real understanding, one who seeks for God.

### III. The typical character traits of the fool Vs 3

- A. All have \_\_\_\_\_ from God;
- B. All have become \_\_\_\_\_
- C. No one does \_\_\_\_\_, not even one!

### IV. The typical \_\_\_\_\_ of the fool Vs 4

- A. Those who do evil seem to never learn from their evil behavior
- B. They think nothing of destroying the righteous
- C. They wouldn't think of praying to the LORD

### V. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the behavior of the fool Vs 5

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ will grip them,
- B. Because God is \_\_\_\_\_ them-for God is with those who obey him

### VI. The overall conclusion about the fool Vs 6

- A. The wicked \_\_\_\_\_ the plans of the oppressed,
- B. But the LORD will \_\_\_\_\_ his people.

### VII. The overall conclusion of the Psalmist Vs 7

- A. The prayer for \_\_\_\_\_-Oh, that salvation would come from Mount Zion to rescue Israel!
- B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the prayer-For when the LORD restores his people, Jacob will shout with joy, and Israel will rejoice.
