1A. The 1st Mark is worship (13:1-4).

2B. See to the application in your own life.

1B. Note 1st again the theological intention of the text.

2B. Now consider this change of action for yourself.

3A. The 3rd Mark is savor the promises of God (13:14-18).

1B. This is the theological intention of this text.

2B. This is the application of the text.
