1 Timothy 2:9-10

Big Idea

Women, (and by implication, men) should carry themselves in such a way that they are noticed, not for their clothes, but for their good works.

Your Clothes Matter

- 1. Women Should Adorn Themselves With Humility and Self Control.
 - a. These instructions are gender specific.
 - b. These instructions emphasize humility expressed in dress.
 - c. These instructions forbid turning the worship of God into a fashion show.

Your Clothes Matter

- 2. Women Should Be Noticed Primarily by Their Good Works.
 - a. These instructions stand in contradiction to the norm.
 - b. These instructions emphasize service of style.
 - c. These instructions are consistent with those professing godliness.

- 1) For Women
 - a. This passage does not discourage beauty.
 - b. Be known for your good works, not your style.
 - c. Check your heart.
 - d. Serve your brothers in Christ well.

- 2) For Younger Ladies
 - a. Don't shrug off the idea of modesty.
 - b. Be modest on your wedding day.

- 3) For Men
 - a. The principles of this passage apply to you.
 - b. Fathers are responsible for leadership in the home (this includes modesty).

- 4) For the Church What should I wear to church?
 - a. What you wear communicates how you care.
 - b. Dress so that your clothes are not a distraction.
 - c. Generations must be gracious and patient with each other. You need each other!
