- 2. How does Paul answer his own question and why?
- 3. How did it happen that we became "dead to sin"? What are some of the implications of this reality?
- 4. How is our baptism a picture of the reality of our being united with Christ in His death and resurrection?
- 5. What difference does the reality of v. 7 (for he who has died is freed from sin) make in your daily life?
- 6. Paul commands us to "consider ourselves to be dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus." How can we actually obey this command this week?
- 7. Let's take some time and thank God for the joy of our union with Christ that has truly and actually freed us from sin and delivered into a new eternal life.
