"...and books were opened...

And the dead were judged according to the

- According to God's exhaustive and perfect knowledge!

(2) A Judgment of Works!

And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books."

- All is remembered! All will be brought to light! cf. Matt. 12:36; Rom. 2:16"

- According to God's perfect righteousness as revealed in His Law!

(3) But a Great Distinction Made! Two sets of books!

-1- "Books" - a record of deeds

-2-"The Book of Life" - a record of names

- The Book belongs to the Lamb that was slain 13:8 "the Book of Life of the Lamb"
- The names have been inscribed from the foundation of the world 17:8

3. The Second Death!

vv. 14-15

(1) All of the dead cast into the lake of fire

"Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire.

This is the second death."

- "The lake of fire" - A punishment and suffering that is not physical but spiritual in nature - Other descriptions:

"torment" – endless conscious suffering – especially spiritual and psychological suffering "they have no rest day or night" 14:11

"outer darkness, there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth" Matt. 22:13; 25:30

(2) The fate of every unbeliever

"And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire."

Further Application

God upon His Throne!
 His Greatness and Majesty

- cf. 4:2

All men called to account in the final judgment!

"Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them."

- Everything centers here, is determined here. All of history ends here!

- (2) His Holiness and Purity
 - Nothing defiled or impure can remain in His presence!
 - The end of the present cosmos may be indicated here, and the ushering in of the new. (21:1)
 - As with the 6th Seal (6:14) and the 7th Bowl (16:20)
 - Or the fact that there is no longer any place to hide when God brings judgment.
- Q: Who will judge all men? The Lord Jesus Christ!
 - cf. The vision of 1:9-20 The letters to the churches
 - Jn. 5:22-23, 27; Acts 17:31; 2 Cor. 5:10

2. The Judgment

v. 11

- (1) A Universal Judgment! "And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God..."
 - After death (the whole of one's life will be in view)
 - All men will stand before God
 - Social status or rank will mean nothing God is no respecter of persons!
 - Believers and Unbelievers 2 Cor. 5:10
