Scripture:	Ephesians 4:17-32

RECEIVE

- Read the passage and listen to Sunday's sermon (if you have not done so already).
- Ask God to help you understand and respond to the passage in faith.
- Reread the passage, taking note of any words or phrases that stand out.

REFLECT

- How does Paul contrast the life of the Gentile (unbeliever) with that of a true believer throughout these verses?
- Paul says that Gentiles are afflicted with a spiritual condition known as blindness (hardness) of heart . What are the effects of this condition and what things in our lives might indicate a movement towards a hard heart?
- What do you think it means to put off the old self and by contrast put on the new self?
- Make a three column list, of the things to put off, their counterpart to put on, and the reason for doings so. Pray and ask the Lord to help show you which of these things you need to change.

RESPOND

- How will you apply any gospel encouragement from your reading and reflection for the day and week ahead?
- What areas of your life have you identified that need to have gospel truth applied, in order for you to receive grace and peace from God?
- Spend some time in prayer with the Lord about the things He has revealed to you in this passage.
- Ask God to help you respond in faith to His word.
- Commit to applying whatever gospel encouragement or challenge you have received into practice.
