- 3. Be reminded of two things: God's infinite grace to sinners; and how God works behind the scenes to bring about His will and work out His plan.





## The Wager and the Riddle

Judg. 14:12, "Then Samson said to them, 'Let me pose a riddle to you. If you can correctly solve and explain it to me within the seven days of the feast, then I will give you thirty linen garments and thirty changes of clothing.

Judg. 14:13, "'But if you cannot explain it to me, then you shall give me thirty linen garments and thirty changes of clothing.' And they said to him, 'Pose your riddle, that we may hear it.'" [NKJV]

## Judg. 14:14, "So he said to them:

- "'Out of the eater came something to eat, And out of the strong came something sweet.'
- "'Out of the eater came forth eats, And out of the strong came forth sweets'
- "Now for three days they could not explain the riddle." [NKJV]

Judg. 14:15, "But it came to pass on the seventh day that they said to Samson's wife, 'Entice your husband, that he may explain the riddle to us, or else we will burn you and your father's house with fire. Have you invited us in order to take what is ours? Is that not so?'

Judg. 14:16, "Then Samson's wife wept on him, and said, 'You only hate me! You do not love me! You have posed a riddle to the sons of my people, but you have not explained it to me.' And he said to her, 'Look, I have not explained it to my father or my mother; so should I explain it to you?' " [NKJV]


Judg. 14:18, "So the men of the city said to him on the seventh day before the sun went down: 'What is sweeter than honey? And what is stronger than a lion?'
