Intro:

READ WLC Q&A 72.

<u>EP:</u> Anyone who believes on Jesus as the Messiah shall be saved by Him.

<u>HP:</u> *You who believe are justified.*

Move 1: It is God's gracious work in you that you have saving faith to be justified.

LC: "saving grace". But we are ... of them that believe to the saving of the soul. (Heb 10:39)

- By a Gracious Savior: LC: "wrought in the heart of a sinner by the Spirit": You don't save yourself.
 - We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; (2Co 4:13). Conversion result of regeneration.
 - o READ Ephesians 1:17-19
- Means Used: LC: "and word of God": ... how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (Rom 10:14, 17)
- Saving Response Generated: LC: "whereby he, being convinced of his sin and misery, and of the disability in himself and all other creatures to recover him out of his lost condition": Source of justification is regeneration.
- When people are born of the Spirit, we see saving faith responses to the Word:
 - Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? (Act 2:37)
 - o And [the jailer] brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? (Act 16:30)
- LC 71, faith <u>required</u>: And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because <u>they believe not on me</u>; (John 16:8-9). SC 32: faith a condition.
- But you are only justified by faith because of Christ's saving work and the Spirit's application of it to you through the gift of faith.
 - o For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. (Rom 5:6)
 - o And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; (Eph 2:1)
 - O Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. (Act 4:12)

Move 2: The Spirit saves you through faith on the basis of Christ's redemptive work. LC: "for pardon of sin and for the accepting and accounting of his person righteous in the sight of God for salvation": Justified on account of Christ's cross work and life's work, not your works. Even faith, though your response, is a gift and thus not a work. Faith not basis, but means.

• And be found in him, <u>not having mine own righteousness</u>, <u>which is of the law</u>, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: (Phi 3:9)

• But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved ... (Act 15:11)

Move 3: You must know the Gospel and believe on Jesus to be justified.

LC: "assenteth to the truth of the promise of the gospel". Agree w/ facts (historical):

- In whom ye also trusted, after that <u>ye heard the word of truth, the gospel</u> of your salvation: in whom also <u>after that ye believed</u>, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, (Eph 1:13)
- To him give all the prophets witness ... Acts 10:43. Knowing certain propositions necessary.

LC: "not only" "but receiveth and resteth upon Christ and his righteousness, therein held forth":

- But as many as <u>received</u> him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that <u>believe</u> on his name: (Joh 1:12). Received/believe synonymous. Faith is belief/trust/reception in the Scriptures. Gospel "promise" is inherently Personal and personal.
- ... <u>Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ</u>, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. (Act 16:31).
- ... through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins. (Act 10:43):
 - The prophets preached the Messiah would also save the gentiles (Abrahamic covenant). Believing on His name (God saves) is what saves not works!
 - o Vs. 42: preaching God's judgment on wicked, thus need to be justified by Him.
 - Vs. 44: Holy Ghost fell upon Gentiles, so baptized. All saved by faith in Jesus, not works Moses.
