5. We Must Be Specific And Share Our Legacy Of Imputed Righteousness Before God, (vs. 25)

A. Imputed righteousness places us in good standing before our God, (vs. 25a); *“One who is righteous is a guide to his neighbor, but the way of the wicked leads them astray. Whoever is slothful will not roast his game, but the diligent man will get precious wealth. In the path of righteousness is life, and in its pathway there is no death.” (Proverbs 12:26-28, ESV)*

B. Imputed righteousness enables us to guard the commands of our God, (vs. 25b); *“Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.” (Romans 10:1-4, ESV)*
