John 6:44-45 *No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.* ⁴⁵ *It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.'*

How God calls:

- God is calling people to salvation **by prayer** (verses 1-4).
 - The Bible teaches **evangelistic prayer** - My prayer for the lost is never **lost**. (verse 1)
 - The Bible teaches a **universal scope** - My prayer for the lost is never **limited**. *1 Tim 2:1-8*
- God is calling people to salvation **by preaching** (verses 5- 15a).
 - You can only call on Him in whom **you have believed**.
 - You can only believe in Him of whom **you have personally heard**.
 - You can only hear of him if **someone tells you**.
 - You can only tell of Him if **someone sends you**. (1 Corinthians 1:20-24)
- God is calling people to salvation **by providence**. (verses 15b-21)
 - God planned to **save** those that believe by faith
 - God planned to **send** those that preach by faith
 - God planned to **make a gift** of the requirement of faith (verse 17)
 - "So faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of Christ."
(NASB)
