Introduction: There was a "game" last week. What were their eyes on ahead of the game? Text today teaches us to get the most important things in focus. Eyes on His Glory – Fixed on His Calling – Looking for His Return. Background:

Author? Luke – little debate from earliest days of the work.

Date? Written before the destruction of the temple and fall of Jerusalem in AD 70? Likely written during reign of Flavius (69-96) - but hard to date precisely

Purpose: - Demonstrated that "the Way" is a way of peace.

- Shows the role/power of the Holy Spirit in fulfilling Christ's mission
- Reveals salvation history, the culmination of a long process of divine revelation in God's ruling and over-ruling in the affairs of men for deliverance of His own people

I. With Our Eyes Drawn Heavenward

- A. His **Glory** is Exhibited *He Is Exalted!! Crucifixion was followed by the Exaltation of Christ!* Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:3
 - 1. In a Glorified Body the first fruits of the *Resurrection!*
 - a) In the Resurrection
 - God vindicates Christ in his sacrifice for sins.
 - Human nature (body and soul) are restored to original perfection and strength.
 - He becomes the life giving Spirit. 1 Corinthians 15:45
 - b) Visited us with a "body of glory" A real body. NOTE: The Incarnation remains- Jesus keeps his resurrected body in heaven. He is still Jesus. Still the perfect God/man. He has a perfect, very real, material body. The Glory of Christ is in His permanent incarnate state.
 - 2. In the Ascension
 - a) It is bodily/physical.
 - b) His person is taken up to heaven a *place*, not a *state*.
 - 3. In a Supernatural Cloud
 - a) Transfiguration Mark 9:7
 - b) Ascension in the cloud?
 - c) His return (parousia) Luke 21:27; Mark 14:62
 - d) Showing forth His glory? Exodus 40:34; 1 Kings 8:10
- B. His Exalted Rule is Established
 - 1. His Kingdom is Spiritual Not an earthly kingdom (John 18:36)
 - 2. He Reigns from Heaven
 - a) He is Exalted to God's right hand. Acts 2:32,33; Matthew 26:64 (cf. Ephesians 1:20-23; Hebrews 10:12; Revelation 3:21)
 - b) Christ received the rule of government over the Church and the Universe!

I. With Our Eyes Drawn Heavenward (continued)

- B. His Exalted Rule is Established
 - 2. He Reigns from Heaven
 - c) He reigns as the Prophet, Priest and King of His people
 - 1) As King he rules and protects His church, by His Spirit.
 - 2) As Priest he continually presents his perfect, finished sacrifice to the Father as the basis for pardoning grace.
 - 3) As Prophet through the Holy Spirit, now given he teaches us the truth, guides us in it, reveals the fullness of Christ. Ephesians 4:10
 - 3. Now he can bestow his gift the Holy Spirit

NOTE 1: Coming of the Spirit in fullness and power required the finished work of the atonement. John 18:14 His "going away" in the crucifixion seemed like a disaster – but it is the key to life!

NOTE 2: The coming of the Holy Spirit is not simply to give us comfort in the absence of the Savior – it is to complete His Presence with us, exhibiting his power and authority.

II. We Keep The Task In Focus

- A. The Angels Bear Witness To the task given
- B. We Must Bear Witness Our work is here!

III. Keeping Our Eyes On The Prize

- A. We Look for His Physical, Visible Return Acts 1:11 **NOTE: His return is** not some invisible "spiritual" return that only the "initiated" can see. He comes with his angels and power. (2 Thessalonians 1:6-8)
- B. We Work Until That Day Comes. The disciples had marching orders. They are standing orders.

IV. Conclusion

- 1. We need times of Gazing at the Son (of looking intently at the exalted, glorified savior.) Are you building that into your life?
- 2. We must be focused on the task at hand living, serving, growing, loving, worshipping, ministering with the power that has been poured into us.
- 3. We must be looking, watching for His glorious return.
