Saul of Tarsus: a sinner forgiven by God's grace.

- 1. He saw the Light (v.1-3)
  - a. Jesus turned the light on his sin.
  - b. Jesus turns the light on our sin.
- 2. He heard the voice (v.4-6).
  - a. It was a **personal** encounter.
  - b. It was a **convicting** encounter. Revealed truth
    - i. Jesus is not dead; he is alive.
    - ii. To attack a Christian is to attack Christ.
    - iii. Jesus is **Lord!**
    - iv. The **goads** of God are hard to ignore.
  - c. It was a <u>life altering</u> encounter.
  - d. We today also hear from God **though his word**. 1 Peter 1:22-25
- 3. He obeyed the **<u>call</u>** (6b-19).
  - a. The call of God left him **humbled**.
  - b. The call of God made him **submissive**.
  - c. We must <u>obey the call</u> To obey is to believe; to believe is to obey.

- Who **am I**? 9:1-5
- Who **is Lord**? Verse 5
- What does the Lord want me to do? Verse 6
