Hypocrite [*hip-uh-krit*] *noun*

1. a person who *pretends* to have virtues, moral or religious beliefs, principles, etc., that he or she does not actually possess, especially a person whose actions contradict their stated beliefs.

2. a person who feigns some desirable or publicly approved attitude, especially one whose private life, opinions, or statements contradict his or her public statements.

John 5:30b; Matthew 5:16b

The right motive for anything that you do is to **honor** and obey the Lord.
