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The Book of Revelation

“Victory”

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Introduction: Chapter one, Chapter twenty two, Chapter 6... come and see..

The key Phrase: "The Revelation of Jesus Christ"

1. There is a promise attached: 1:3
2. The Author is John: This is John's fifth book..

Note:

Daniel wrote the book of Daniel, as Daniel prophecy did not see the Rejection of Israel Acts chapter seven.

- Daniel's prophecies could have fulfilled in Acts 2 - Acts seven, but become partially fulfilled. The church age is introduced and revealed by Paul (Acts 9) 12:7, Ephesians 1:17, 3:3. 2 Corinthians 12:7

And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

Statement:

The Revelations given to Paul Galatians 1:14-18, were not given to Daniel (Israel). Daniel did not see the church age nor write about it. John who wrote John, 1,2nd &3rd and Revelation on the Isle of Patmos. Peter wasn't given the revelation directly as Paul was 2 Peter 3:15-16, but ministered to the church. (Galatians and Hebrews have themes you should remember..)

- The book of Revelation has some of Daniel latter prophecies, because the church has been taken out Revelation 4:1-2, as it is what John sees, hear-after. The Book of Daniel also pics... Acts 2:20, Matthew 24:29, and Revelation 6:12:13.

Note:

Prophecy is to be considered, or not fully understood until after the fact. What John sees and records, are glimpses of future event.

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A. Revelation is seen on a number of fronts;

1. It shows the down fall of Satan...[Rev 12:12](#).
2. It is the book that finishes the Bible..
3. It is the end of the time of the gentiles [Luke 21:24](#), [Romans 9 and 11](#).
4. It brings in the fifth kingdom Daniel [2:44 and 34](#) the millennial, thousand year reign, second advent of Jesus Christ.

B. The last book compared to the first book "Genesis"

5. Genesis the sun and moon appear:

[Revelation 21:23](#)

And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

6. In Genesis the marriage of the first Adam, in Revelation there is the marriage of the second Adam. (**Bride...Saints whose names were written in the book of life...**)
7. Genesis man was driven out of the garden, in Revelation man is received [Revelation 22:1-3](#)

[Revelation 22:2](#)

In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

8. Genesis is the first appearance of the Enemy Satan and Revelation is the final fall. [Revelation 12:12](#).
9. Genesis is beginning of sorrows, and Revelation is the end.

[Revelation 21:4](#)

And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

10. Genesis is the beginning of the curse [Genes 3](#) and Revelation is the end

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Revelation 22:3

And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:

11. Man was driven out but now is received Revelation.

C. The themes of the Book of Revelation.

12. It give a glowing testimony of Jesus Christ as the Triumphant one, the key phrase is the revelation of Jesus Christ ...the word Lamb is mentioned sixty six times, as "it is written" in the New Testament is also sixty six times.. (26 times the sacrificial Lamb..)

13. The church age is mentioned by the seven churches of Asia. It show that The Lord Jesus Christ is head over the **Church**.

1. The church is never mentioned as being on earth...

1. The judgment seat of Christ takes place **Romans 14:10, 2 Corinthians 5:10, 1 Corinthians 3:10ff..**

Statement:

I believe that we have to receive our rewards or losses before we return with to reign with him or not...**2 Timothy 2:12**

14. The one church that is still on earth is mystery Babylon

Revelation 17:5

And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

Note:

There are seven mysteries in the bible, The mystery of Godliness 1 Timothy 3:16, of Christ in you Colossians 1:26-27, Israel cut off Romans 11:25, the meeting of the Lord in the air 1 Corinthians 15:52 and the Mystery of Iniquity 2 Thessalonians 2:7

Note:

You should know them and learn them: **1 Corinthians 4:1**

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Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.

3. The church has been removed and the Great tribulation takes place from **chapter 4:1-4**
 1. The period that John sees **Revelation 12:12-17** is the 3 and half year period of **Jacobs trouble 42 months**. (God does not take his Bride through Jacobs trouble..
 2. John writes using the law of **recurrence**, the same in fashion as the synoptic Gospels...
4. The man of sin is revealed in Revelation chapter six as in **2 Thessalonians 2:10**. The man of sin "known as the anti Christ is the main character to the beginning, middle and the end of the Great tribulation, **Matthew 24:21**. (He has a name which will also be revealed **Revelation 13:18**)

Note:

Because the Book is the Revelation of Jesus Christ, it stands for to reason the one who oppose the Revelation of Jesus Christ as it was in the first Advent is seen as false Christ, sent to **deceive**, to take the throne of David **2 Thessalonians 2:9-1**.

Take note:

1 Corinthians 2:8

Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

(They found out after the fact and wouldn't have crucified him, Revelations the second advent ...where there is war to oppose Him and there are those that want to receive Him)

Revelation 11:15

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ;

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and he shall reign for ever and ever.(what a blessing)

This is the triumphant victory, the kingdoms offered to Jesus in Matthew four and in the book.

In chapter five [Revelation 5:5](#) is the sealed book [Isaiah 29:11](#) and [Daniel 12:4-9](#). (This not the book of life..)

Conclusion:

This lesson is not a study on the wrath of God and nor an explanation that covers the political and religious period. The period covers the fulfilment of Daniel's seventieth week, also called the Great Tribulation spoken by Jesus Matthew 24:21, it is the darkest time before dawn, it is a time where men hearts are revealed, it is a time where judgment is revealed on earth, Hand in Heaven is the Judgment seat of Christ before his thousand year reign. This brings the time of the Gentiles to an end, and Jesus Christ taking war to set the kingdom of heaven on earth. [Luke 21:24](#)
