## The Incident with Dinah Genesis 34:1-31

## Main Point:

Instead of loving the world, love your Savior and live entirely for Him.

1. You need to beware of the allurement of the world.

2. You need to beware of fearing the world.

3. You need to beware of compromising with the world.

4. You need to beware of retaliating against the world.

5. Instead of loving the world, you need to love your Savior and live entirely for Him.

**Proverbs 7:21-22** <sup>21</sup> With her enticing speech she caused him to yield, With her flattering lips she seduced him. <sup>22</sup> Immediately he went after her, as an ox goes to the slaughter ... (NKJV)

**Numbers 33:55-56** <sup>55</sup> `But if you do not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then it shall be that those whom you let remain *shall* be irritants in your eyes and thorns in your sides, and they shall harass you in the land where you dwell. <sup>56</sup> `Moreover it shall be *that* I will do to you as I thought to do to them.'" (NKJV)
