Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Genesis 2:15-17**; **Ephesians 2:1-3** and **Genesis 3:8**. Consider the biblical dimensions of the word "death" as you tie the truths of these passages together. Why is it important to not see this as simply biological death?
- 2. Read **Colossians 2:13-14**. How would you explain the need for Christ's death to someone who asks, "Why is Christ necessary for our forgiveness?"
- 3. Read **1 Corinthians 15:12-19**. What are some of the differences between religious people who don't believe (or act like they don't believe) that Christ conquered death, and those who clearly affirm and live in light of this truth?

4. Read **2 Timothy 1:8-12**. Look carefully at the details of this passage. What aspects of this text push you to get more excited about relaying the "good news" to others?

5. Read **Psalm 32:1-7**. What practical steps can you take to keep the invaluable doctrine of God's forgiveness of your sins in the forefront of your mind more often?
