ISAIAH 4:2-6

(4:2) In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and glorious and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel.

(4:3) And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy; even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:

(4:4) When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

(4:5) And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defence.

(4:6) And there shall be a tabernacle for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain.

I. The Definition of the Day of the Lord

Isaiah 4:2,
In that day . . .



The Phrase, “IN THAT DAY”

(2:11) The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the Lord alone shall be exalted IN THAT DAY.

(2:17) And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the Lord alone shall be exalted IN THAT DAY.

(2:20) IN THAT DAY a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made each one for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats;

(3:7) IN THAT DAY shall he swear, saying, I will not be an healer; for in my house is neither bread nor clothing: make me not a ruler of the people.

(3:18) IN THAT DAY the Lord will take away the bravery of their tinkling ornaments about their feet, and their cauls, and their round tires like the moon,

The Definition of the Day of the Lord

The Negative Side of the Day of the Lord includes God's wrath being poured out in judgment on pride, which is seen in man's unbelief, idolatry and disobedience.

The Positive Side of the Day of the Lord focuses on God's mercy and love being poured out on a remnant that He rescues/delivers/saves.

The End Result of the Day of the Lord is the exaltation of the Son of God, where He is given the preeminence and the glory by both those judged and those rescued.

II. The Description of the Lord

Isaiah 4:2,

. . . shall the branch of the LORD
be beautiful and glorious . . .

THE BRANCH

Isaiah 11:1,

And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a **BRANCH** shall grow out of his **roots**:

Isaiah 11:10-12,

And in that day there shall be **a root** of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.

And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

THE BRANCH

Isaiah 53:2,

For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

THE BRANCH

Jeremiah 23:5-6,

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous **BRANCH**, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called **THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS**.

THE BRANCH

Jeremiah 33:14-18,

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised unto the house of Israel and to the house of Judah.

In those days, and at that time, will I cause the BRANCH of righteousness to grow up unto David; and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land.

In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The Lord our righteousness.

For thus saith the LORD; David shall never want a man to sit upon the throne of the house of Israel;

Neither shall the priests the Levites want a man before me to offer burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and to do sacrifice continually.

THE BRANCH

Zechariah 3:8-9,

Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before thee: for they are men wondered at: for, behold, I will bring forth my servant the **BRANCH**.

For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.

THE BRANCH

Zechariah 6:12-13,

And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaks the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD:

Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

III. The Delineation of the Land

Isaiah 4:2,

. . . and the fruit of the earth
shall be excellent and comely . . .

The Delineation of the Land

Isaiah 35:1-2,

The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God.

Isaiah 60:13,

The glory of Lebanon shall come unto thee, the fir tree, the pine tree, and the box together, to beautify the place of my sanctuary; and I will make the place of my feet glorious.

IV. The Destination of the Left Behind

Isaiah 4:2,

. . . for them that are escaped of Israel.

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN-YEAR TRIBULATION

Matthew 24:21-22,

For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

And except those days be shortened, there should be no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN-YEAR TRIBULATION

Revelation 12 - War in Heaven between Michael and his angels and the dragon and his angels.

Revelation 12:12,

Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

Revelation 12:13,

. . . he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child.

Revelation 12:17,

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN-YEAR TRIBULATION

Zechariah 12:3,

And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people, all that burden themselves with it will be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered against it.

Zechariah 12:9,

And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

Zechariah 14:1-2,

Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee. For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle;

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN- YEAR TRIBULATION - Armageddon

Revelation 16:14,

For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

Revelation 16:16,

And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN- YEAR TRIBULATION - The Revelation

Revelation 19:11,

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Zechariah 14:3-4,

Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east.

Revelation 19:15,

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations; and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

THE JEWISH SURVIVORS OF THE SEVEN-YEAR TRIBULATION

Romans 11:26-27,

And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written,
there shall come out of Sion the Deliverer,
and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall
take away their sins.

V. The Designation of the Living

Isaiah 4:3,

And it shall come to pass,
that he that is left in Zion,
and he that remaineth in Jerusalem,
shall be called holy . . .

VI. The Determination of the Lamb's Book of Life

Isaiah 4:3,

. . . even every one that is written
among the living in Jerusalem:

THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE

Exodus 32:32-33,

Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin – and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written.

And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE

Psalm 69:28,

Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous.

Daniel 12:1,

And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at the time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

Malachi 3:16-17,

Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE

Luke 10:20,

Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Philippians 4:3,

And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellow laborers, whose names are in the book of life.

Hebrews 12:23,

To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect.

THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE

Revelation 3:5,

He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Revelation 21:27,

And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.

VII. The Demonstration of the Love of God

Isaiah 4:4,

When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion,

and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof

by the spirit of judgment,
and by the spirit of burning.

The Work of Jesus Christ

Zechariah 12:10,

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one MOURNETH for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

Zechariah 13:1,

In that day there shall be a fountain opened to all the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

The Work of Jesus Christ

Zechariah 13:6-7,

And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.

Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.

The Work of Jesus Christ

Zechariah 13:8-9,

And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD,
two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left
therein.

And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them
as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried:

they shall call on my name, and I will hear them:

I will say, It is my people:

and they shall say,

The LORD is my God.

THE WORK OF THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD

Revelation 4:5, “and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of the Lord”

Isaiah 4:4,

- (1) by the spirit of judgment,
- (2) and by the spirit of burning.

Isaiah 11:2, “THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD SHALL REST UPON HIM”

- (3) the spirit of wisdom
- (4) and understanding,
- (5) the spirit of counsel
- (6) and might,
- (7) the spirit of knowledge

VIII. The Depiction of the Luminous Canopy: The Shekinah Glory Cloud

Isaiah 4:5,

And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies,

a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night:

for upon all the glory shall be a defence.

The Bridal Canopy

Joel 2:16,

Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

Psalms 19:5,

Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

THE PILLAR CLOUD/FIRE AND THE GLORY OF GOD FILLING THE TABERNACLE

Exodus 13:21-22,

And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night: He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, from before the people.

Exodus 40:34,

Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

Exodus 40:38,

For the cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

The Pillar Cloud/Fire and the Glory of God Filling the Temple

1 Kings 8:10-11,

And it came to pass, when the priests were
come out of the holy place, that the cloud
filled the house of the LORD,

So that the priests could not stand to minister
because of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD
had filled the house of the Lord.

The Departure of the Glory of God from the Temple

Ezekiel 10:18-19,

Then the glory of the LORD departed from off the threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubims.

And the cherubim lifted up their wings, and mounted up from the earth in my sight: when they went out, the wheels also were beside them, and every one stood at the door of the east gate of the LORD's house; and the glory of the God of Israel was over them above.

Ezekiel 11:23,

And the glory of the LORD went up from the midst of the city, and stood upon the mountain which is on the east side of the city.



The Coming of the Glory of God in Christ and His Departure

John 1:14,

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt (Greek -“tabernacled”) among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Acts 1:9,

And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

Acts 1:12,

Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day’s journey.

The Return of the Glory of God to the Third Temple

Ezekiel 43:1-2,

Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that locket toward the east:

And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.

Ezekiel 43:4-5,

And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the east.

So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.



IX. The Declaration of the Lasting Tabernacle

Isaiah 4:6,

And there shall be a tabernacle
for a shadow in the daytime from the heat,
and for a place of refuge,
and for a covert from storm and from rain.

THE GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT

Revelation 20:11-12,

And I saw a great white throne, and him that set on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Revelation 20:15,

And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
