Ephesians 5:3-14

I. We must flee sexual immorality to keep from final condemnation (vv. 3-6).

II. We must flee sexual immorality to keep from present contradiction (vv. 7-14).

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What sins does Paul warn us against here?
- 2. If we live in unrepentant sin and walk as the world does, what does Paul tell us will happen to us at the future judgment? Why?
- 3. What reason does Paul give Christians in v. 8 for why they should walk in the light?
- 4. What does Paul mean when he calls us to expose the works of darkness? How do we do this?
- 5. How did God save Augustine from his sin? Where did Augustine find true life and joy and how did this deliver him from his love of sin?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. Have I allowed sexual compromise in my actions, words, thoughts, or desires?
- 2. Am I a closet sinner? If people saw the way I lived behind closed doors would they see contradiction and hypocrisy?
- 3. Am I desirous to always live under the light of Christ's presence? Is the light of His countenance and the superior joy of His person driving me to put to death sexual sin?
