Psa 103:1,2 BLESS the LORD - VIBRANTLY

PRELIMS. These verses are associated with communion – but they were not written with communion in mind! It has a wide **application**

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>

This psalm of David is oozing with **energy!** He is so vibrant! He is 'throbbing' with excitement. He is **full** of gratitude to the Lord, he really wants to **demonstrate** his love for God! Do **you** know the feeling? If not, **why** not? As Xians we ought to feel the same! For the very **reasons** David wanted to thank God, **we too have** these very reasons!

Praising God is a wonderful occupation – it makes you **more** content and **happier**! It **helps** you **psychologically**! You know, some Xians feel 'down' a lot! I believe 1 **reason** for that is we do **not praise** God enough! To be thankful **does** help us **psychologically!**

But **not only** psychologically, it **also** helps us **physically**! Well it did the Psalmist, look: "your youth is renewed like the eagle's" [5b] Praising God is a recipe for staying young! David was **not** the **only** one who thought so – Isaiah "those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles, they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint" [Isa 40:31]! It is not right to feel older than you are! Too many Xians have the **'Old Age Syndrome'** and long for **retirement**! We are meant to **overcome** and not 'give-in' to lazy tendencies, and aspire to greater things! I have heard someone say re 'Life begins at 40', 'You haven't lived until your 60!'

The Psalmist here **realised** he was going thru an 'Old Age Syndrome' period - and got **out** of it! But **how** did he get **into** it? The same way, you/I/Joe Bloggs get into it! He tells us: 'He **forgot** God's **goodness** to him'! "and **forget** <u>not</u> all His benefits"[2]! He got '**used to**' all the **daily benefits** that surrounded him! He took them for granted!

How did he **get out** of it? By doing what the **old hymn** says: 'Count Your Many Blessings, name them one by one, and it will surprise what the Lord has done'! So before we look at **how** we can praise God, lets look at the **many blessings** David and **we** have!

5 GREAT BLESSINGS WE TAKE for GRANTED

Food & Drink! "who satisfies your desires (mouth) with good things"[5]. When was the last time you really didn't know if you would have anything for tea? Did it **ever** happen to you? Tell, what determined the **place/family** you would be brought up in? God's will! What prevented **you** from being one of those children we see on TV scrambling for 1 grain of rice? God's goodness to you! Butter mountains, wine lakes! We go to the supermarket – our biggest problem? The **choice**, so many **varieties**! Not 'Any bread left?'

Health & Strength! "who heals all your diseases" [3b]. Go to hospital, asylum and you will realise how healthy you are come back thankful! How many of us are in **real pain**? The amazing thing about the human body is **not** that we at times get ill – but that we are not ill **all the time** – there are so many complex organisms, and each interdependent on the other, the wonder is we live so long! If our **temperature** goes up 2 degrees we are in trouble! But God has built-in a self-recuperating system! A **cold** and **cut** heals itself!

When did you last say 'Thank you Lord for my food & drink, my health and my strength, and for healing me from that cold and bruise I had last week'?

Freedom & Liberty! "who redeems your life from the pit" [4] How many of us live under **tyranny** where you have **no freedom** to rest, to read, watch TV or go out? To redeem is to 'set free from boundaries'. Joseph was in a pit! In prison! Jeffrey Archer knows a little more about freedom now – because he was in prison! We, in the west, take our freedom for granted. Persecuted Xian brethren in Indonesia, Nigeria know about boundaries! They are watched day & night! Guards come and ask 'What are you reading?'

Forgiveness of Sins! "who forgives all your sins" [3] "He does not treat us as our sins deserve" [10]. To think that we have sinned deliberately/consciously and yet God had forgiven – completely! How would you feel if God said, 'for every sin, just 1 hour in hell'? If what Shor Cat says is true 'Every sin deserves God's wrath and curse both in this life and in that which is to come' is true, then 1 hour in hell is a bargain! Yet God does not do things by half! He redeems/forgives totally and not only saves us from hell but takes us to heaven as well!

To 'crown it all' God Floods us with Love/Compassion! "and crowns you with love and compassion" [4b]. Innumerable daily blessing too many to count! "How vast the sum of them. Were I to count them they would outnumber the grain of the sands" [Psa 139:18]! "You crown the year with Your bounty... Your carts overflow with abundance" [Psa 65:11] We don't just get a steak, potatoes – garnished with peppers, sauces, spices, trimmings! Not just a bed at night – an electric blanket! Not just a car – heater, air-conditioned, wipers – so different from horse-back! Not just 1st class post – telephone, email! Etc. We can't just say 'its man's progress' - plenty people today without them!

Yes – count your many blessings – it will make us thankful!

HOW to THANK GOD for HIS MANY BLESSINGS

Tell God how wonderful He is! "O Lord my God You are very great" [104:1] "Praise the Lord" [1] Thank Him **personally** for all His goodness to you! Look: "When I look up into the heavens... What is man that You are mindful of him?" [Psa 8:4] God is glorified when we praise Him. It is a **great sin** to refuse to praise God! Tell Him you **love** Him.

Tell Yourself about God's wonderful works to you! **Remind** your self of all His benefits! The Psalmists were constantly 'speaking to themselves' (not Old Age Syndrome!) "Why are you cast down, my soul?" [Psa 42] "Awake, my soul. Awake harp, lyre" play a tune [Psa 57:8] "How then can you say to me 'Flee as a bird' "[Psa 11:1]. Eli misjudged Hannah? So passionate about her concern - speaking to herself! We must **strengthen** ourselves by telling ourselves the **Truth**! "Say to my soul 'I am your salvation' "[Ps 35:3] "Do not put your trust in **princes** (politicians)" [Ps146:3] Believe God instead!

Tell Others about God's goodness to you. "Give thanks to the Lord, call on His name, make known among the nations what He has done" [Ps 105:1] People won't mind it! It may even 'draw' them to the Saviour. "publish among the nations" Paul asked for prayer "to open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel" [Eph 6:19] Why don't we call on others to "taste and see that God is good"? [Ps 34:8] Forget not!
