- 1. Be ready for **<u>opportunities</u>** (3:13-17)
 - Doing right will <u>bless</u> the world
 - Reacting right will reveal your <u>blessing</u>-
 - <u>Be brave in persecution</u>
 - Be bold in persecution Be ready always!
- 2. Be <u>repulsed</u> by the old life (4:1-3)
 - We were saved <u>from</u> our sins Ro 6:11
 - We were saved <u>for</u> our Savior *Ro 6:13-14*
 - We have spent enough time in <u>sin</u>.
- 3. Get<u>real</u> about opposition (4:4-5)
 - Your restraint makes <u>no sense</u> to this world.
 - Your restraint makes <u>no friends</u> of the world
 - You restraint does give <u>a warning</u> to the world
 - Your restraint does give an **<u>opportunity</u>** to the world.
- 4. Start rejoicing over fellowship in Christ's sufferings (4:12-16
 - Persecution is no cause for <u>worry</u>
 - Persecution is a cause for glory
 - Persecution is not a cause for <u>shame</u> Phil 3:7-11
- 5. Do remember Suffering is sometimes part of God's plan (17-19)
