- \* We Need To Have A Tender Heart! How? Two Ways:
- I. By Being Sensitive Toward <u>SIN</u> (V. 12-13) (We Should Be Afraid Of Offending God)
  - A. Be Sensitive Enough To:

    <u>Ask For Pardon</u> For Unknown Sin (Ignorance) (V. 12)
  - B. Be Sensitive Enough To:

    <u>Desire God's Protection</u> From Willful Sin (Arrogance) (V. 13a)
  - C. Be Sensitive Enough To:
    <u>Fear The Potential</u> Of Rebellious Sin (Defiance) (V. 13b)
- II. By Being Sensitive Toward <u>GOD</u> (V. 14) (We Should Be Concerned About Pleasing God)
  - A. Be Concerned That Your Words Please Him (V. 14a)
  - B. Be Concerned That Your Thoughts Please Him (V. 14b)

Conclusion: \* Sensitivity toward God has everything to do with being sensitive to the voice of God as He speaks through Creation (v.1-6) and through His Word (v.7-11).
