

- A. During the first three hours our Savior hung on the cross, Golgotha was full of activity and commotion.
- B. In stark contrast to those hours were the second three - quiet, hushed - for God had spoken!

Deeds of Darkness (4) Christ Bearing Our Curse

I. Amazing Darkness.

- A. Two points underscore the amazing character of this darkness at Golgotha.

- B. The only explanation for this darkness is that it was a work and word of God.

II. Significant Darkness.

- A. Generally, darkness is a sign of God's judgment.

- B. Specifically, this darkness was a sign of God's judgment on Christ, and on the Jews.

III. Temporary Darkness.

- A. This judgment was temporary. At the ninth hour, light returned!

- B. In this return of light is both a warning to those who persist in unbelief, and a word of assurance to all true believers in Christ.
