  - A. Laodicia was known for its material possessions.
    - -- sold black wool
  - B. Laodicia was known for its geological attractions.
    - -- Cold and Hot springs
  - C. Laodicia was known for its medical solutions.
    - -- Salve for the eyes "Essential oils"

## II. The description of the Savior. (14b)

- A. He confirms the truth. the AMEN
- B. He defends the truth. the faithful and true witness
- C. He established the truth. the beginning of God's creation

### III. The condition of the church. (15-17)

- A. The members were outwardly productive but inwardly stagnant. (15-16)
- B. The members were financially stable but spiritually bankrupt. (17)

### IV. The invitation to the church. (18-20)

- A. Repent and believe the Gospel. (18-19; Isaiah 55)
- B. Accept and enjoy the Gospel. (20; Luke 24:29-30; John 14:23)

### V. The reward of the conqueror. (21-22)

- A. Authority over the nations. (21a; 2:26; 20:4; John 12:26; 2 Tim. 2:12)
- B. The Promise of the King. (21b; 5:5; 6:2; 17:14; John 16:33)
  - -- Put the two concepts together and they mirror the words of Christ in Matthew 28:19-20!
