THE ARRIVAL OF THE DIVINE JUDGE - Rv 11:19

INTRODUCTION

- **1.** Today we complete 1st 1/2 of Rv Rv 11:15-19. Distinguish but not separate Christ's redemptive kingdom & God's universal kingdom which we enter by faith in Christ our Redeemer & Judge Mat 24-25; Jn 5:29.
- 2. v18 Final Judgment [FJ]. Scene is set for arrival of the Judge v19

1st: God's Heavenly Temple Will Be Opened - v19a

- **1.** Rv11:1-2 *temple* = Church on earth: true & apostate. v19 *temple in heaven* = transcendent realities w/ wh/ we engage in worship; revealed at Eschaton
- 2. v19a = general statement & v19b&c = are 2 descriptive phrases. Temple opens & Jn sees *ark of His covenant* & phenomenon assoc'd w/ Mt Sinai.
- **3.** Where will Jdgmnt occur? God's temple-palace-throne room. King as ruler, warrior, judge.
 - i. Rv 4:1-6 Throne of God the Creator.
 - ii. Rv 5:13 Lion of Judah/Overcomer Lamb seated on throne: Redeemer
 - iii. Rv 8:1-5 FJ [7th seal]: furniture of temple [altar: martyrs]
- **4.** FJ: King Jesus enthroned in glorified humanity; we accountable for our *deeds*
 - Rm 2:6 cite Ps 62:12. Our deeds are the result of God's loving kindness.
 - ii. Rm 2:9-11, 13 note *does* we are legally justified by grace alone in Christ alone thru faith alone. In FJ, our faith will be vindicated by the evidence of deeds that validate a living, not dead, faith & our deeds will be rewarded. Motivates us to be zealous for good works [Tit 2:11-14]
- 5. Rv11:19 FJ administered by Jesus Rv 1:13-18

2nd: The Blessings of God's Temple Will Be Given to His People - v19b

- 1. *Ark of His covenant* = symbol of blessing for people of God <u>Ex 25:8,21-22</u>
 - i. Lord present to rule & redeem
 - ii. Lord present to conquer in battle
 - iii. Likely destroyed in 587BC Babylon deportation of Judah
- 2. Ark of <u>His</u> covenant God's lovingkindess. <u>Rv 21:3-4,22</u> throne = ark of His covenant; no *temple* b/c God is present *all and in all* [1Cor 15:28].

3rd: The Terror of Mount Sinai Will Be Given to God's Enemies - v19c

- 1. Cycle of 6 trmpts [Rv 8-9] plagues. Now $w/7^{th}$ trmpt: Sinai. Need mediator!
- 2. Ex 19:16-19 Do these people fear God?

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- 3. <u>Heb 3:14-4:2</u> heard Word w/o faith we too hear Word [4:2].
 - i. <u>Hb 12</u> after *by faith...* [Hb 11] <u>v18-24</u> the revelation given to us in NCov exceeds that given in OCov: not Mt. Sinai, but Mt. Zion
 - ii. Hb 12:25-26 contrast us & those who heard God's voice at Sinai
 - **a.** *not refuse Him speaking* [Hb 1:1-2 *spoken to us in His Son*]
 - **b.** If OCov people were *warned on earth* by God's *voice* wh/ *shook earth then* = Sinai, how much more are we warned by God who speaks from heaven & warns a 2nd time of a future Sinai-like shaking [earthquake] of cosmos <u>Hag 2:5-9</u>
 - iii. Hb 12:27-29 compresses Sinai & Haggai's prophecy: earthquake of FJ
- 4. Rv 11:18-19. End of 3rd cycle; end of 1st 1/2 of Rv; end of age: FJ

Applic #1: Rejoice in Being Given Access into the Temple of God

- 1. NCov worship is one of the things that will remain thru the earthquake of FJ.
- 2. Hear God's words w/ faith Hb 4:1-2.

Applic #2: Live Your Life Oriented to the Coming Judgment

- 1. What could be more 'practical' than knowing we are headed to FJ [2C 5:10]?
- **2.** Our deeds includes motives [Rm 2:16; 1C4:5] our words [Mat 12:36] & the moral substance of our lives: relationships, work, stewardships.
- 3. The *fear of God*: aware of accountability to God Ps 130:4 <u>Rv 11:18</u>
- 4. 2 Cor 6:16-7:1. Worship & holy living, pious communion w/ Christ.

Applic #3: A Man With No Fear of God Faces a Fearful Eternity

- 1. <u>Rv 11:18</u> *eternal <u>destruction</u> <u>2Thes 1:7b-10</u>*
- $\label{eq:continuous} \textbf{2.} \quad \text{See the eternal significance of what we are doing here today.}$
- **3.** Bow before King Jesus now, as He comes to you in the gospel as the Savior of sinners. If you come to FJ w/o the provisions of His grace, you face Jesus as Judge & you will begin to pay the penalty of eternal destruction.
- 4. Repent, trust in Jesus & begin to follow Him: today!
