- 1) Is God through with the Jew? (verses 1-24)
 - a) No because not all Jews have rejected Christ (verses 1-4)
 - b) No because by grace He saved a remnant (verses 5-10)
 - c) No because man's performance does not cancel His purpose (verses 11-24)
 - i) God is reaching gentiles to reach the Jews (verse 11)
 - ii) God will restore the Jews to reach the world (verses 12-15)
 - iii) God made the first Jews holy and he can make the later Jews holy too (verse 16)
 - iv) God can convert gentiles so He can complete Jews. (verses 16-24)
- 2) God will do what God will do (verse 36)
 - a) God's plan cannot be frustrated (verse 25-31)
 - b) God's wisdom cannot be calculated (verse 33)
 - c) God's ways cannot be anticipated (verse 34)
 - d) God's knowledge cannot be elucidated (verse 34)
 - e) God's person cannot be obligated (verse 35)
 - f) God's mercy cannot be over estimated (verse 36)
